GENERAL GUIDELINES

The administration, faculty, and staff have the authority to make decisions based on the appropriateness of dress as it conforms to the dress code. Violations will be handled as needed. Consequences for violations range from asking parents to bring a change of clothes, to the loss of dress-down days. Other consequences to be decided by the administration, faculty, or staff. The administration may grant exceptions from the dress code for a given group, class, or the entire school because of special days, events, and field trips. Clothing should be neat, clean, and comfortable - NO OVERSIZING OR UNDERSIZING.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE

FOR GRADES K-8

- Hair should be neat, clean, and worn in traditional styles. A small amount of naturallooking, subtle hi-lighting is acceptable. Hair should not obstruct a student's vision.
- A small amount of natural-looking makeup is acceptable. NO body paint, glitter, stickers, decals, or tattoos. Makeup and/or nail color should not be excessive or distracting.
- Necklaces, bracelets, "stud" earrings, and sport-approved earrings are acceptable. Earrings must be limited to one per earlobe and may not hang below the earlobes. Jewelry should not be excessive or distracting.
- Middle School detail: P.E. dress code will be determined by P.E. teachers.

DOs AND DON'Ts

- Hoodies MUST be Hawkwear hoodies only and students may NOT wear hoods in the school.
- Students must tuck in shirts and wear a belt.
- No Leggings as pants you can wear leggings under skirt/dress, but you may NOT wear them as pants (especially on N.U.T/Spirit Days).
- On Spirit Day, students must wear approved Hawkwear clothing. See Spirit Day on Page 5.
- No ripped or torn jeans.
- Students can wear a coat/jacket for outside if they need a sweatshirt/sweater/hoodie for inside it must follow our dress code guidelines.
- No body paint, glitter, stickers, decals, or tattoos. This includes students writing on themselves!
- No hats or distracting head attire in the building.

SHIRTS (White, Red, Black)

Shirts must always be tucked in. Shirts may be oxfords, polo shirts, or turtlenecks. Oxfords and polo shirts may have long or short sleeves. Solid color white, red, or black undershirts may be worn under uniform shirts. (Logos are available through Lands' End and Schoolbelles, but they are not necessary.)



PANTS (Khaki, Black)

Slacks may be flat front or pleated pants. No Denim.







SWEATERS (White, Red, Black)

Schoolbelles and Lands' End crew neck pullovers, cardigan sweaters, and a V-neck vests. All sweaters are to be worn over a uniform shirt.



SKIRTS • GIRLS 4-8 (Plaid)

Skirts must be no shorter than 4" above the knee in length, but no longer than the bottom of the knee. If skirts are too short, drop the hem to increase the length.



JUMPERS • GIRLS K-3 (Khaki, Plaid, Red)

Khaki (Lands' End twill jumper), White/Red/Black plaid (Schoolbelles V-neck pleated jumper), or Red (Lands' End cotton polo dress). Jumpers must be no shorter than 4" above the knee in length, but no longer than the bottom of the knee.



BELTS • GRADES 1-8 (Khaki, Brown, Black)

Students must wear solid-colored belts in the belt loops of pants and shorts.



SHORTS (Khaki, Black)

Shorts must be no shorter than 4" above the knee in length but no longer than the bottom of the knee.



SKORTS • GIRLS K-8 (Khaki, Black)

Skorts must be no shorter than 4" above the knee in length, but no longer than the bottom of the knee.



SWEATSHIRTS (White, Red, Black)

Plain crew neck sweatshirts, ³/4 zips, and fleece jackets can be worn. They must be worn over a uniform shirt. (School logos are optional through Lands' End and Schoolbelles.)



SOCKS (White, Red, Black, Khaki)

Solid-colored socks (trousers, ankle, knee-highs, and/or tights/leggings) must be worn at all times.



SHOES

Athletic shoes, low-heeled dress shoes, and boots are acceptable. No sole may be higher than 1" on any shoe. Shoes must be closed-toe. Athletic shoes must be worn to P.E. class.



SPIRIT DAY AND N.U.T. DAY

SPIRIT DAY (HAWKWEAR)

St. Charles Hawkwear or a completely plain white, red, or black shirt, sweater, or sweatshirt may be worn. Jeans or plain white, red, or black athletic pants or shorts may be worn. Shorts must be no shorter than 4" above the knee in length. If you are not participating, you must be in uniform.



NOTES ON SPIRIT & N.U.T. DAY

N.U.T. DAY: (NO UNIFORM TODAY)

A shirt, sweater, or sweatshirt may be worn. Jeans or athletic pants or shorts may be worn. Shorts must be no shorter than 4" above the knee in length. If you are not participating, you must be in uniform.



- No sleeveless shirts, no midriff, no bare stomachs, no running shorts, no tights/leggings worn as pants, no ripped or torn jeans, and no inappropriate or suggestive language or images. Shoes must be closedtoe. Clothing should not be excessive or distracting.
- Please keep in mind that all Spirit and N.U.T. Days are a privilege. The administration may suspend Spirit and N.U.T. Days if the guidelines are not being followed.
